FLTT – BUSINESS TROPHY 2026 : REGULATION

1. As far as not otherwise stated by the present 'Regulation', the ITTF rules and the FLTT regulations apply to all the matches of the Tournament. These provisions may be consulted at or downloaded from the following homepages:

 - <https://www.fltt.lu/federation/statuts-reglements> (Fédération - Statuts & Règlements).
2. The Tournament is run by the FLTT Technical Commission (TC), under the guidance of a Referee and a Tournament Director.
3. The power of final decision is with the Referee, who may, if important or critical items have to be decided, set up a Jury, chaired by himself and including moreover the Tournament Director (or his deputy) and one or more representatives of the participating teams. In this case, the power of final decision is with the Jury, the Referee having a casting vote in case a Jury voting ends in a tie.
4. The Tournament consists of two stages: a qualification stage and a final stage.
 - 4a. For the qualification stage (Q-ST), the participating teams are drawn in groups with 3 to 6 teams each. These groups are set up in view of the playing strength of the players composing the teams.

In each group of the qualification stage, each team is playing each other team.

In the qualification groups, the two (2) top ranked teams in each group qualify for the F-ST; for groups of 3 teams, only one (1) top ranked teams qualifies for F-ST.
 - 4b. The final stage (F-ST) consists of four Leagues, as follows:
 - ◆ Gold League (GL), including teams ranked 1 & 2 in Q-ST groups 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, each of the 6 teams qualified for the GL playing each other team;
 - ◆ Silver League (SL), including teams ranked 1 & 2 in Q-ST groups 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.4; teams will be split in 2 groups of 4 teams each; teams ranked 1 & 2 in these groups (q-F-ST) will play semifinals and finals for 1st to 4th place;
 - ◆ Bronze League (BL), including teams ranked 1 & 2 in Q-ST groups 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4; teams will be split in 2 groups of 4 teams each; teams ranked 1 & 2 in these groups (q-F-ST) will play semifinals and finals for 1st to 4th place.
 - ◆ Challenger League (CL), including teams ranked 1 in Q-ST groups 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, 4.4; each of the 4 teams qualified for the CL playing each other team.
5. Any team match consists of three or six single matches (each best-of-3 sets) as follows:
 - ◆ in a group with 3-4 teams, a team match consists of 6 single matches: | A1-B2 | A2-B1 | A3-B3 | A1-B1 | A2-B3 | A3-B2 |
 - ◆ in a group with 5-6 teams, a team match consists of 3 single matches: | A1-B1 | A2-B2 | A3-B3 |
 - ◆ in semifinals/finals (if any), incl. q-F-ST groups, a team match consists of 3 single matches: | A1-B1 | A2-B2 | A3-B3 |
6. The final score of a team in a team match will be given by the number of single matches this team has won in the team match concerned. The winner of a match earns 3 match points; in case of a tie both teams earn 2 points each; the loser receives 1 point in a played match (none for a match which is not played or is not completed).

In case of a tie between two or more teams, FLTT regulations will apply to determine the ranking.
7. All the matches are played with plastic competition balls of the brand DONIC P40+***.
8. The players of a team not engaged in a single game shall hold office as umpires. A player refusing to hold office as umpire may be excluded from the Tournament by the Referee.
9. In order to avoid, that the ball can't be seen by a player, the clothes worn by the players during the matches shall basically not be white nor include important parts of white colour.
10. In each League, the three top ranked teams in the final ranking are awarded a trophy, offered by the FLTT.
11. All the participating players are covered by the two insurance policies contracted by the Ministry of Sports:
 - third party liability ['responsabilité civile']
 - permanent disability ['invalidité permanente']
13. Any player taking part in the table tennis Tournament 'Business Trophy 2026' is doing so at his own risk and responsibility.
